

## **Dean/CEO Ruidoso Campus Position Available Jan. 2005**

Eastern New Mexico University invites applications for the position of dean of the Ruidoso Off-Campus Instruction Center (ENMU-Ruidoso) in Ruidoso, New Mexico — the beautiful mountain resort playground of the Southwest.

The center is a two-year, state-supported, campus serving approximately 1,500 credit and non-credit students per semester. It offers occupational/technical and general/liberal education courses leading to associate degrees and occupational certificates through local, web-based and remote site classes. It prepares students for immediate job entry, career updating, transfer to four-year institutions and lifelong learning. It also provides customized training for business and industry, and workforce training for the mountain resort communities in which it resides.

The position is an excellent opportunity to lead a single college district that, since its creation in 1991, has been one of New Mexico's fastest growing campuses. The dean is the local spokesperson for the ENMU system and is expected to connect closely with college employees, students and the community/region. The dean's leadership is crucial for the system's growth and retention goals, effective administration of the Ruidoso campus and the economic and social development of the area. The dean will also be responsible for the transition in 2005 (subject to legislative approval) to a new branch (comprehensive) campus status. Upon attainment of branch status, the dean's title will change to provost and report directly to the ENMU system president. Salary range \$85,000-\$91,000.

### **Requirements:**

Earned doctorate from an accredited institution and five (5) years senior level administrative experience required. Administrative experience at the community, branch, or junior college level strongly preferred, but service as a K-12 school system superintendent or senior administrator at a university considered.
